2022 Virtual College and Career Fair Scholarship Awards Official Rules

Official contest name

WCCAN 2022 Virtual College and Career Fair Scholarship Awards.

Prizes

Three (3) scholarship awards, each in the amount of \$1,000.

Contest entry start date

March 1, 2022

Contest entry end date

May 4, 2022, 2:59 p.m. Eastern Time, when site registration officially closes.

Event date

Wednesday, May 4, 2022; 12 - 3 p.m. (EST)

Contest eligibility

Open to all eligible high school students that both successfully register and participate in the WCCAN 2022 Virtual College and Career Fair.

Administrator's address

Contest will be solely administered by the Southeast Michigan Community Alliance (SEMCA), Taylor, MI 48180.

Method of entry

Each eligible high school student must successfully register for and participate in the WCCAN 2022 Virtual College and Career Fair Scholarship Awards through the official student online registration site at <https://student.novva.tech/semca22>

Successful registration and participation will be deemed confirmed by SEMCA through the student registration database made available by the platform provider, NOVVA Tech; if the student registration does not appear in this database, a student is not considered eligible regardless of any other activity.

Only one entry per student allowed regardless of e-mail account used to register.

Awards will be made solely at the discretion of SEMCA; no other rights are implied or inferred to any other party with regard to the awarding of the scholarships.

Method of award determination

Each successfully registered and participating student will count toward the accrual of one entry unit attributed to the student's school. At the end date/time of the contest noted above, SEMCA will then tabulate how many units of entry each institution will be afforded.

These units will then be collectively inserted into a drawing. Following this, three winners will be drawn and then awarded accordingly.

Only one winning entry per school will be awarded.

For example, if ABC High School has 20 of its students successfully register and participate in the event, then ABC High School will receive 20 entries in the drawing featuring its school as the identifier. If one of the three winning units drawn is from ABC High School, then ABC High School will receive one of the three \$1,000 scholarships.

The odds of winning increase based on the number of students at a school that register, thereby increasing that school's chances of having it selected from among all of the entries. For example, if ABC has 20 students successfully register and participate and another school only has 10, then ABC has twice the chance to be awarded one of the scholarships than this other school.

ABC High School will then determine how to individually award the \$1,000 scholarship to one of its student event participants.

SEMCA will have no involvement or responsibility over how each individual school awards these scholarships with the exception that only students from its school who registered and participated in the event are eligible.

All entrants will abide by all applicable laws including privacy policies and that the use of entry information from entrants will only be used for the purpose of the contest administration.

Schools will make available to SEMCA the names of winners.

Any and all monetary liabilities such as taxes are the responsibility of the winners.
