PROGRAM DETAILS

This program provides comprehensive training for students who wish to prepare for entry into a career in Information Technology (IT). This program provides students with the knowledge required to sit for three international certification exams. The CompTIA A+ Core Series requires candidates to pass two exams: Core 1 and Core 2, and one exam leads to the CompTIA Network + Certification.

A+ Certification indicates technical ability and signifies the competence to support a wide variety of hardware and software. Network + Certification validates that students have the knowledge needed to use and maintain a wide range of networking technologies and have proficiency in networking administration and support. Upon completion of this program, students will be prepared for international, vendor-neutral certifications in a growing and in-demand field.

This 18-week online certification program is delivered via Remote Mentored Learning (RML). Students can view the video content from anywhere with a high speed internet connection, and have access to an Online Mentor, who provides ongoing support throughout the program.

This program is designed to be completed within a prescribed amount of time, with responsibilities for each course thoroughly outlined in order to pace the program effectively.






Upon completion of the program, students will have one-on-one exam preparation for each exam with a MedCerts subject matter specialist. Each exam preparation period can last from 4 to 6 weeks.
